

# Old Bonhomme Road Restoration Project



CONSTRUCTION WILL BEGIN AT OLIVE AND OLD BONHOMME BEGINNING MONDAY JUNE 20<sup>TH</sup>.

TRAFFIC FLOW WILL BE **WEST/NORTH BOUND** ONLY BEGINNING MONDAY JUNE 20<sup>TH</sup> BETWEEN **LYNNE CT** AND **OLIVE**. BE AWARE OF LANE SWAPS TO ACCOMMODATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. TRAFFIC WILL BE EAST AND WEST BETWEEN **LYNNE** AND **DIELMAN**.

MAIL TO OLD BONHOMME ADDRESSES WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE WILL BE DELIVERED TO TEMPORARY MAILBOXES ON LYNNE COURT.

## Construction Zone Safety

- Drive slowly and cautiously
- Remain calm. Construction crews will accommodate you as efficiently as possible. In active working areas, wait for a signal before proceeding
- Keep children away from equipment and materials. It is difficult for workers to see children, and there are many potential hazards.
- Children and parents are welcome to watch from a safe distance.
- Cyclists should watch for construction vehicles in the work zone and ride or walk their bike on the grass when a vehicle is in the vicinity

## Trash, Recycling and Yard Waste

Present your collection materials at the curb just like normal. Construction Crews will allow Republic Services trucks into the construction zone.

## Property Owner Utilities

Property owners should inventory any sprinkler, dog fence or landscape lighting that is near the project limits and make arrangements to have this items marked or moved. Contact the project liaison if you have any questions.

**Spencer Contracting is focusing construction efforts adjacent to OB Elementary.**

**Both traffic lanes between Dielman and Price will be open the week of June 27<sup>th</sup>. Paving will take place after sidewalks and curbs are completed on the entire project.**

## Process

Existing rolled curbs and gutters will be replaced with mountable concrete curbs. The Contractor will need to pour the curb across driveway entrances to create a continuous gutter line. As part of the project driveway aprons will be replaced. Spencer Contracting will notify each property owner to schedule work. If no one is home a door hanger will be left at your property with contact information. In some cases they will replace the apron and sidewalk in 2 sections to allow continuous property access. Concrete has a minimum curing time of five days, so you will be unable to use your driveway at least this amount of time. The City's Contractor is required to give residents 72 hours notice prior to limiting access to a driveway.
