

**Olivette City Council  
Worksession  
June 6, 2023  
Minutes**

Mayor Weil called the meeting to order at 7:05pm on June 6, 2023 in the Council Chambers.

Upon Roll Call the following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Weil, ProTem Carl, Councilmember Waldman, and Councilmember Knox. Councilmember Clark arrived shortly after roll call.

Also present were Interim City Manager Mann, Parks and Recreation Director Beverly Tucker-Knight, and Asst Parks and Recreation Director Patrick Magee.

**Discussion of FY2024 Budget**

Park and Recreation Director Tucker-Knight and Asst Parks and Recreation Director Magee presented on revenue projections, usage and history of fees of the parks and recreation department in anticipation of the opening of Five Oaks on Warson. Discussion ensued on anticipated use, classes and programming anticipated to be in the new community center and structure of program offerings. Interim City Manager Mann provided handouts on overall summary of all funds, line item detail of departmental expenditures, 10 year capital summary and detail, FY24 capital purchases requesting to be appropriated with budget bill, FY24 full time equivalent of employees, and finally FY24 proposed salary scales. Mann stated that little had changed in any of the documents since past discussions on the budget which occurred during regular council meetings.
